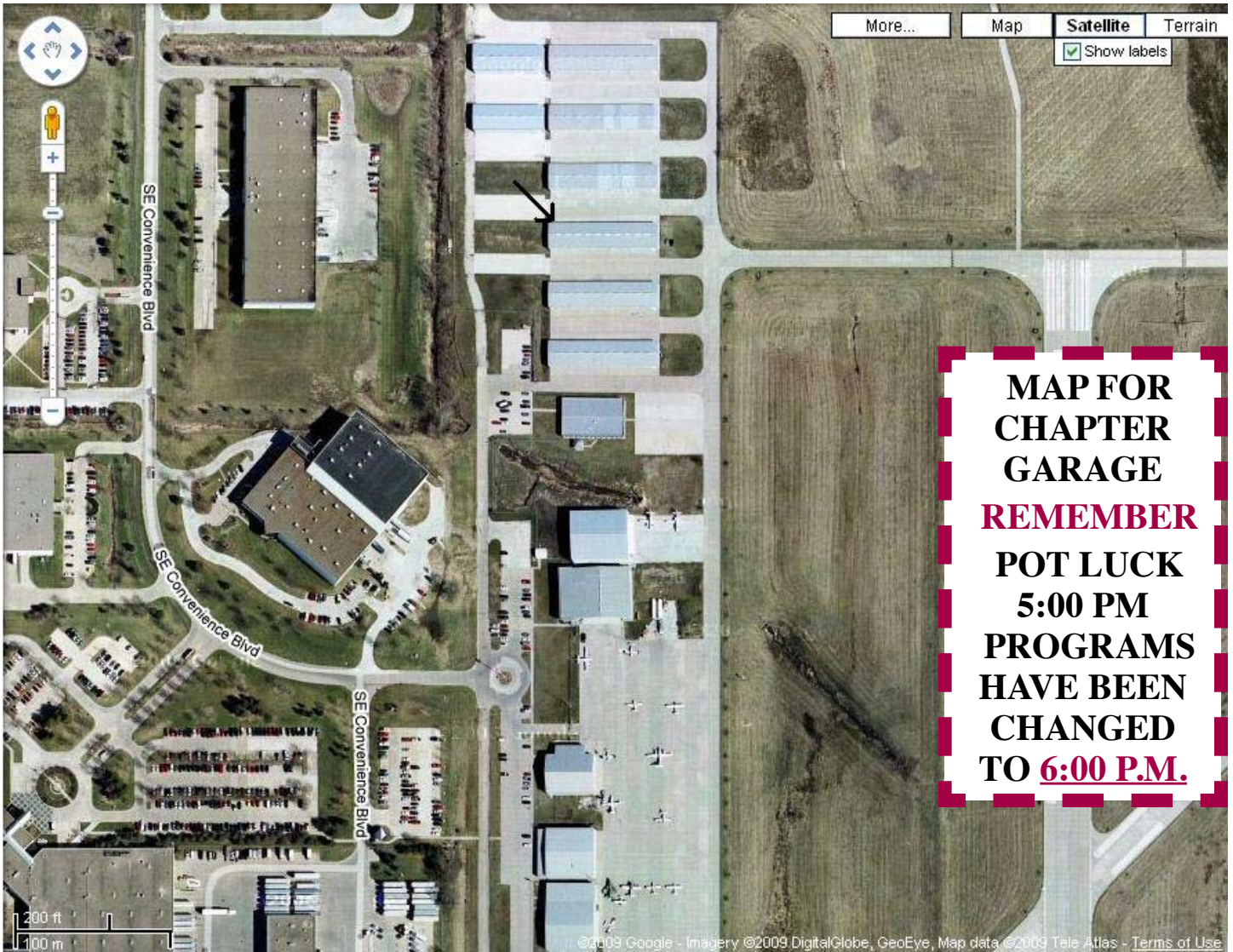

The obituary below was in the newspaper.
He sounds like a pretty amazing guy

Col. Kenneth L. Reusser, 89, a highly decorated Marine aviator who was shot down in three wars, died June 20 in Clackamas, Ore. Reusser flew 253 combat missions in World War II, Korea and Vietnam and was shot down in all three — five times in all. His 59 medals included two Navy Crosses, four Purple Hearts and two Legions of Merit. After retiring from the Marine Corps, he worked for Lockheed Aircraft and the Piasecki Helicopter Corp.
